Dear Parents,

YEAR 6 CONFIRMATION

Confirmation for our Year 6 students will take place this year. We will have to modify our celebrations to comply with health and safety requirements.

Provided we have no further outbreaks of Coronavirus, DHHS has indicated that after Sunday, 22nd November, a group of 100 people will be permitted to gather inside a church for liturgical celebrations. With this in mind, we will be scheduling 8 separate Masses over a 3-week period and we will be giving families the option to nominate which one of these Masses they would like to attend.

Below are some important procedural guidelines.

Each student will be permitted to be accompanied by their sponsor and two family members - **a total of 4 people per family.**

The Masses have been scheduled for the following times:

- Tuesday 24 November 7pm
- Wednesday 25 November 7pm
- Thursday 26 November 7pm
- Friday 27 November 7pm
- Tuesday 1 December 7pm
- Thursday 3 December 7pm
- Friday 4 December 7pm
- Tuesday 8 December 7pm

All Masses will take place in the St Francis of Assisi Parish Church and social distancing protocols & modified seating arrangements will be in place.

- There will be a professional photographer enlisted to take photos of the candidates as they are anointed during the Mass and after the Mass with Fr Anthony. There will not be a charge for photographers as the school will cover the expense as a small gesture of thanks for the patience, support and understanding of families during this most challenging year.
- All Masses will be live streamed so additional family members may view the ceremony.
- **The previously suggested option of students receiving Confirmation in February/ March in 2021 will no longer be possible as the Archbishop has only delegated his authority until the end of this year.**
- Families are invited to discuss the above arrangements and nominate the Mass which they wish to attend by registering their preference on the digital booking system.
- Families may wish to liaise with other families to coordinate a convenient date so that students are able to celebrate this special sacramental milestone with their friends where possible.
- Our numbers need to be strictly capped at 22 families per Mass to comply with the necessary health and safety protocols and we ask for your assistance and understanding in this matter.

I encourage parents to positively support students as they work through their feelings about their class placement for 2021.

END OF YEAR ARRANGEMENTS FOR OUR YEAR 6 STUDENTS

It is difficult to make a final decision for our Year 6 Graduation. At the moment, I am hoping that we will have a formal lunch catered for in our School Hall on Friday 11th December for all our Year 6 students.

I am unsure whether we can have Mass or what involvement our Year 6 parents can have. We will be looking to record the day and organise access for our Year 6 parents via a Landing Page as we did for our Remote Learning. On this day the Year 6 children will be dismissed at 3.30 pm and it will be the last day they will be attending St. Francis as a student.

Parents please note; that these arrangements may change as restrictions ease in time.

VACATION CARE

BEGINNING OF SCHOOL YEAR—2021 - ASSESSMENTS

We will again follow a similar routine as this year, in that we will conduct testing with students on the first two days of the school year (Year 1 to Year 6). ***Students from Year 1 – 6 will begin their first formal day of school on Monday, 1st February, 2021.***

Year 1 - 6 students will have an appointment for a one hour test on either Thursday 28th January or Friday 29th January. We will again use the online booking system. Instructions for this will be sent home Tuesday 8th December with Christmas Cards. **(Bookings will open at 7 pm on Tuesday, 8th December.)**

- * Please note that the **Prep grades** will have a staggered start commencing:
- * Thursday 28th January (8.45 am – 12.30 pm). Children with Surnames beginning with the letters A – L.
- * Friday 29th January (8.45 am – 12.30 pm). Children with Surnames beginning with the letters M – Z.
- * Monday 1st February (8.45 am - 12.30 pm). All Prep students begin with the rest of the school.

CSEF

The Department of Education and Training (DET) has now extended the eligibility to qualify date for CSEF to 5th October 2020. If you hold a valid means tested health care card or are a foster parent, you may be eligible for CSEF. Your card must be valid no later than 5th October 2020. The school can accept CSEF applications up to **Wednesday 25th November 2020** however parents are encouraged to lodge their forms early as we are unable to accept late applications. The school also requires a copy of your current health care card. The CSEF payment for primary students eligible between Wednesday 15th April 2020 and Monday 5th October 2020 is \$62.50. The CSEF is paid to your child's school to be used towards camps, sports and excursions.

FAMILIES NOT RETURNING TO ST. FRANCIS IN 2021

If your family is not planning on attending St. Francis next year, please let the school know. I have had many enquiries from families who wish to enrol into our school in 2021.

COVID 19 – SCHOOL SAFETY PROTOCOLS

We will continue to stagger our start times to lessen the volume of foot traffic through the gates at one time.

8.45 am: Gates will open (all families with surnames beginning **A – L** to enter the gates).

9 am: All families with surnames beginning **M – Z** to enter the gates.

This is for families who are choosing to walk their children into school. All gates will be open in the morning, including the gate near the Year 1 classrooms.

If you are using one of our three drop off points in your car (Church, Teacher's Carpark, Oval) you may drop your child off any time from 8.45 am. Please do not allow your child to exit the car until 8.45 am.

Please note – no parent is to enter the classroom before or after school. If you need to communicate with your child's teacher please continue to do so via phone or email. The Parent Helper Program will not be operating until further notice.

- When you do walk your child in through the gates, we ask you to adhere to the following:
- Maintain a respectable social distance from other parents / staff members
- Please walk your child straight to their classroom (do not allow children to play on playground equipment)
- When you arrive at your child's classroom you are to remain at least 10 metres away from the classroom entrance (this allows you to see your child enter the classroom so you can relax for the rest of the day!)
- We ask that you minimise your time on site during drop off and pick up. Please do not socialise in the school yard.

Please support us in managing this.

AFTERNOON PICK UP

End of school day arrangements will remain as normal (3.30 pm finish time for all students). Please follow the rules of social distancing, not entering classrooms or using playground equipment at the end of the day. All gates and pick up / drop off points will be open at the end of the day also.

We are very efficient at clearing the school grounds by 3.45pm, and there should not be anyone remaining on school grounds after this time. Please ensure that your children do not play on the playground after school and that you do not stay on the school grounds to chat with friends. Thank you for your support.

TEMPERATURE CHECKS:

Classroom teachers will continue to conduct temperature checks when students enter the classrooms in the morning. Following this protocol has allowed us to identify sick students who haven't had COVID-19 but we have intercepted the spreading of the common flu.

HEALTH AWARENESS - What to do if your child is unwell:

It is important to note with the return to school of all primary students, COVID -19 will only remain at bay if we continue to guard against its transmission.

Therefore, we remind you to please keep your children at home if they, or any family members, have any symptoms of COVID-19. Should a child be sent to school with cold or flu symptoms they will be assessed in First Aid and you will be notified immediately to collect them. Your child will be isolated until you arrive, so it is very important that you are prompt.

In line with the Department of Health guidelines, we strongly encourage you to present your child for testing if they present with flu like symptoms. Your child must then remain in quarantine, at home, until their result has returned.

If your child or a family member tests positive to COVID-19 it is important that you contact the school immediately in order to further reduce the transmission of the virus to other students and staff.

MASKS

As per the Chief Health Officer's recommendations primary school children are not required to wear masks. This is of course optional - if children wish to wear masks, they are most welcome.

Teachers are not required to wear masks when in the act of teaching but are required to wear one when moving around the school (including when on duty and travelling to/from school).

All parents / adults who come onto the school grounds are required to wear fitted masks (shields and bandanas are no longer allowed).

Please Note: that there are individuals who cannot wear masks due to medical reasons, so please be respectful of their circumstances. We are all here to support and care for each other.

BOOK FAIR

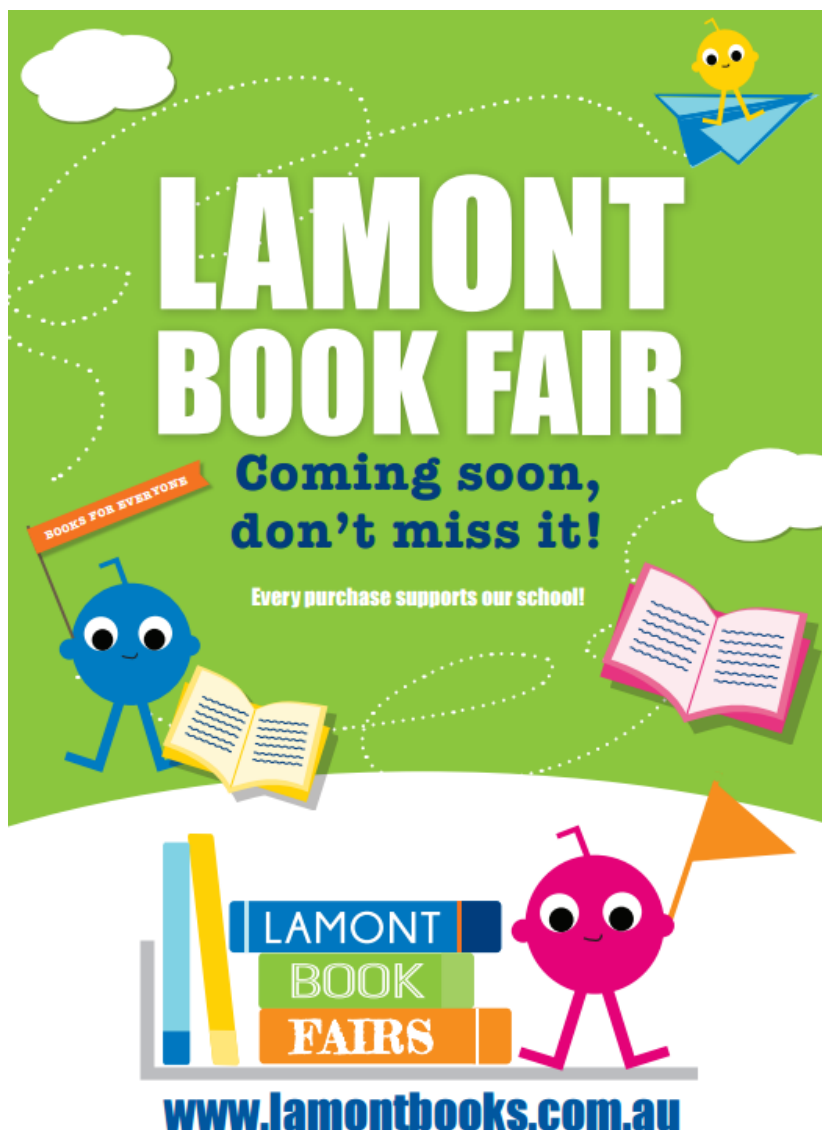
We have enjoyed seeing the students again in our Library this term and they have certainly been very enthusiastic when borrowing some new books.
